MANNA ANNOUNCES WINTER FUNDRAISER AT CAVA

Harbor Springs, MI – The Manna Food Project of Harbor Springs is hosting their first annual wintertime fundraiser on Tuesday, February 23, 2010. Cava (formerly Latitude), the newest culinary experience opened by Chandler Symons, has donated their Bay Harbor restaurant as the event location.

The Manna Food Project is a food pantry and warehouse, providing food product to 38 pantries throughout Emmet, Antrim, and Charlevoix Counties. Over 1.7 million pounds of food was distributed to area agencies serviced by Manna during 2009 – a number up 40% from the previous year. As a food pantry, Manna is open for services on Tuesday mornings.
